We're delighted to host you for your Corporate Volunteer event on **October 27** from **10 AM to 3 PM** at our **Hospice Gardens** located at **20 Dumbreck Road**, **Bellahouston Park, Glasgow, G41 5BW.** With your support, our patients and their families can continue to enjoy our beautiful and calming landscape during their hospice stay.

While volunteering, your staff will play an integral part in our grounds process. They will assist with a variety of garden tasks like weeding, watering, litter removal, and with a variety of seasonal tasks. Your team will be supervised by **Michael Howe**, our Maintenance Supervisor. *Again, we can only accommodate groups of up to 10, unless spoken to and arranged prior.*



The nearest rail station is Dumbreck Station that is a 10–15-minute walk from our location. Unfortunately, we do not have a close bus stop, but many lines are easily accessible in short-walking distance.

For those of you driving... We are located at **20 Dumbreck Road, Bellahouston Park, Glasgow, G41 5BW.** We are located next to House for An Art Lover and Glasgow Ski & Snowboard Centre.



Parking is available in our onsite parking lot. However, we cannot reserve space and the lot can get very busy with our hospice programs and café traffic. If the lot is full, we have permission to use the **Bellahouston Bowling Club's Parking Lot**, located at 2 Dumbreck Road for this period.



Once you arrive, Michael, our incredible Maintenance Supervisor, and I will meet you in the reception area next to our Hospice Shop. From there we will give you and your team a small tour of the hospice and share a bit about *what* we do and *why* your help is so graciously appreciated. After, Michael, will lead you and your team to your volunteer post.





You are more than welcome to bring your own lunch as we have ample seating in and outside the building. However, we hope you'll enjoy a delicious and photo-worthy meal at our **Bargacree Cafe**. On top of our diverse menu, we offer a range of daily specials.
